

Privacy and Cookies Policy

The purpose of this Privacy and Cookies Policy is to explain the principles under which your personal data is processed and to outline your fundamental rights related to our processing of your personal data.

I. Data Controller

1. Pursuant to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (EU Official Journal L 119 of 04.05.2016) – GDPR, I hereby inform you that the Data Controller of personal data on the website **mulinovecchio.com** is **Lucjan Mżyk**, with the registered address at ul. Lipnicka 123/3, 43-300 Bielsko-Biała, Poland.
2. Your personal data will be processed for marketing purposes on the basis of:
 - Article 6(1)(a) – consent of the data subject,
 - Article 6(1)(f) – legitimate interest of the controller,
 - Article 6(1)(b) – performance of a contract, of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (GDPR).

II. Your Rights

Current legislation grants you a number of rights related to the processing of your personal data:

1. the right of access to personal data,
2. the right to rectification of personal data,
3. the right to erasure of personal data,
4. the right to restriction of processing,
5. the right to object to processing of personal data,
6. the right to data portability,
7. the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (President of the Personal Data Protection Office),

8. the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data, if you have given such consent.

III. Purposes for Which We Process Your Personal Data

In the course of his activities, **Lucjan Mżyk** collects and processes personal data for purposes arising from the legitimate interests pursued by him as the data controller, in order to provide services to Clients and to conduct marketing of services. This may include:

- sending e-mail notifications about interesting offers or content, which in some cases may include commercial information (newsletter or educational service),
- carrying out other direct marketing activities regarding goods and services (sending commercial information electronically and telemarketing activities) – legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

IV. Cookies

1. The website uses cookies or similar technologies (hereinafter collectively referred to as “cookies”) to collect information about your access to the website (e.g., via computer or smartphone) and your preferences. They are used, among other things, for advertising and statistical purposes as well as to adapt the website to your individual needs.
2. Cookies are pieces of information that contain a unique reference code which the website sends to your device in order to store and sometimes track information about your use of the device. They usually do not allow the identification of a person. Their main purpose is to better tailor the website to your needs.
3. Some of the cookies used on the website are available only for the duration of a given session and expire after closing the browser. Other cookies serve to recognize you when you return to the website and are stored for a longer period.
4. Cookies used on this website help assess the actual interest in the service, to better understand user expectations and preferences, to analyze how users interact with the website, and—by using the latest technological solutions—to continuously improve the service, making it more user-friendly and better tailored to your needs.
5. All cookies on this website are set by the administrator.

6. All cookies used by this website comply with applicable European Union law.
7. Most users and some mobile browsers automatically accept cookies. If you do not change your settings, cookies will be saved on your device.
8. You can change your cookie acceptance preferences or adjust your browser so that you are notified each time cookies are set. To change cookie settings, adjust the settings in your browser.
9. Please note that blocking or deleting cookies may prevent you from fully using the website.
10. Cookies will be used for essential session management, including:
 - recognizing you when you have previously visited the website, which allows identification of the number of unique users who have used the service and ensures sufficient capacity of the service for new users,
 - adapting elements of the website's layout or content,
 - collecting statistical information on how you use the website, in order to improve the website and identify which areas are most popular with users.
